



Request for a tennis licence:

We would like to inform you that our club requires every player to have a licence from the Luxembourg Tennis Federation (FLT) for several reasons:

- Medical check-up to ensure that there is nothing to prevent you from practising a sport
- For insurance reasons
- So that the association can benefit from subsidies from the municipality/state
- A licence from the FLT is mandatory in order to participate in interclubs / tournaments

Note: We require a licence even if you do not wish to take part in official competitions. The licence in no way obliges you to take part in competitions.

To obtain a licence, please complete the following steps and send the information to licence@tcmersch.lu:

1. Medical examination of the athlete:
 - From the family doctor (or paediatrician) if the athlete is younger than 7 years or older than 50 years
 - At the Medico Sportif in a recognised centre, if the athlete is 7 years old or older (or will be 7 years old this year) but not older than 50 years. Go to the website www.sports.lu and select "RV MÉDICO-SPORTIF"
2. Copy (photo) of both sides of the identity card (Jpeg format)
3. Copy (photo) of both sides of the social security card (Jpeg format)
4. Photo of the athlete (Jpeg format).
5. For non-Luxembourgish nationals, an additional form must be completed if no licence is available abroad.
6. For non-Luxembourgish nationals with a licence abroad, we need the current ranking.

The club will then apply for the licence from the FLT and will also pay the annual fees.

Only requests for a licence via the email address licence@tcmersch.lu will be accepted and processed.
